Social Distancing

United Lutheran has been in contact with the Northeast Nebraska Public Health Agency. They are allowing drive-in services but have guidelines for how these services should be done. Please follow these guidelines as you participate:

- **Windows must remain closed.**
- **Vehicles must be 8 ft. apart** (on the sides - not the back and front).
- **Only household members should be in your vehicle.** Don't go hopping from vehicle to vehicle.

Also note:

- **Our church building and bathrooms will be closed.** We apologize for the inconvenience.

Arrival

- Enter from the back of the church parking lot on W 4th Street. Our front entrances will be blocked off.
- In the parking lot, rows will be marked to space vehicles 8 ft. apart. Please park in one of these rows.
- We have scheduled 3 services (6:30, 9, and 10:30 AM) in hopes that we will have enough parking space. If the parking lot is full, please return for the next service.

Participation

- **Listen:** You will listen to the service through your car radio. **Tune your radio to 102.9 FM.**
